IF IN EAR or over-ear headphones aren't your thing, then how about a neckband design? These Logitechs are made of water-resistant polycarbonate, and if the fluorescent green doesn't float your boat, they're also available in a graphite finish – thank God.

Pop them on and thanks to the design, you'll hardly notice you're wearing them. Our main concern is the volume level – they are really quiet, so using them in noisy places isn't viable. Although they're not the best around, they are a cheap and cheerful upgrade.

Sennheiser MX500

AT JUST £15 these in-ear headphones are a bargain, and come in black or white – so you can pick which ones you want depending on the colour of your MP3 player. In action, the MX500s deliver more detail, bass and tonal purity than the 'phones you get bundled in with your portable. They are an absolute bargain, too: music is smoother, with previously unheard voices and musical instruments vying for attention. These are the cheapest worthwhile upgrade you can make to any MP3 player or iPod.

Beyerdynamic SX10

ARE YOU FED up with your earphones falling out at inconvenient moments? Does the prospect of spending hundreds of pounds on a pair of in-ears scare you? Then the SX10s from Beyerdynamic could be right up your half-pipe. Like most accessories, they are available in iPod-friendly white or black. The SX10s deliver a punchy, solid sound, with plenty of bass weight. The midrange is expressive, while the top-end remains composed, even at high volumes. Whether it's in the gym or on the piste, these will rock.

Sennheiser PX100
